MEI GRADUATION REQUIREMENT

Every student enrolled in Grade 10, 11 or 12 at MEI should attempt to meet the MEI graduation requirements below. By doing so, students will receive the *Dogwood Diploma* from the BC Ministry of Education. MEI Students must complete a minimum of **80** credits in grades 10, 11 and 12 credits. Below is the breakdown of required and elective credit requirement. Students should prepare well to ensure they get the credits they need to achieve their goals.
