Individual Programs

- MEI Schools have an average enrolment of 1600 students, but maintains a maximum international student population of 60 students. The MEI student body is entirely composed of native English speakers.
- High academic/behavioral standards require students, even after school acceptance, to maintain appropriate standing.
- MEI is committed to maintaining ethnic diversity in the international student population.
- Individual student acceptance is based upon academic standing, personal recommendation and space in grade level.
- The International Program's high school graduation rate is 100%, with a 90% university acceptance rate.
