



MEI SECONDARY SCHOOL INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM TUITION FEES

2024 – 2025 School Year

| ITEM | FEE | DETAILS |

| Registration at MEI | \$2000* | Registration fees cover MEI administration and is a one-time payment. |
| Tuition | \$16,800 | Includes ESL instruction as needed and course integration with Canadian students and a Dogwood graduation diploma if courses are completed. Also includes in-school tutoring. |
| Student Activity Fee | \$600 | Includes student activities within the International Program, does not include school-based activities. |
| Total Program Fees | \$19,400 | Due upon acceptance into MEI (including registration fee) |

| Medical Insurance | \$1600 | Private insurance and BC Medical coverage for a one-year period |
| Homestay | \$1200/month | This monthly fee is paid directly to the host family beginning after the first month and for the last month before departure. (For Senior sports or music involvement and a special diet, an additional \$100.00 per month will be charged) *First and last month homestay deposits to be paid with tuition. |
| Homestay Placement Fee | \$300 | A one-time fee for new students. |
| Guardianship | \$600 | Guardianship Fee for Custodianship Services |
| Additional English Language Support | \$500 | Includes in school and after school additional English language support. |
| Airport Arrival and Transportation Fee | \$400 | Additional airport transportation will be calculated between the host family and the International Program |

***New Students:** A \$2000 registration fee is required to secure placement at MEI. The balance of payment is due upon acceptance into MEI's international program. Registration fee is required for an official acceptance letter.
